### Independent Mental Capacity Advocate Service

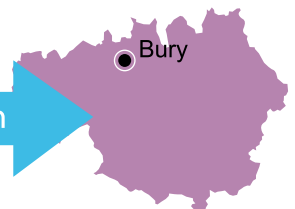
The Mental Capacity Act 2005 makes provisions for an IMCA Service; this service provides an independent safeguard to support people who lack capacity to make important decisions who have nobody to support them. The Act places a **duty** on Local Authorities and/ or NHS bodies to **instruct** and **consult** an IMCA when making decisions for a person regarding:

- Serious Medical Treatment
- Change of Accommodation

Additionally Local Authorities / NHS bodies **may** instruct an IMCA in cases of:

- Care Reviews
- Adult Protection Cases
